A few days later he received a message via the disabled website threatening: "I will stop only after you pay me the money. I advise you to quickly reply to me as the attack is very bad impact (sic) on your business." Mr Ravell ignored the ex-trationite and contacted

Mr Ravell ignored the ex-tortionist and contacted police and he was eventu-ally able to stop the attack by temporarily blocking overseas networks and re-moving the targeted pages until the barrage subsided. advise businesses to choose web hosts that were able to protect from DoS attacks after he was left disap-pointed in his own provider, one of Australia's largest. NSW Fraud and Cyber-crime Squad commander Detective acting Superin-tendent John Watson said DoS attacks were uncom-mon, but anyone targeted in a cyber attack should cona cyber attack should contact the Computer Emerg-ency Response Team for ency Response technical advice.

"They should also report the matter to their local police, especially if it is accompanied by an extor-tion attempt," he said. An offshore cyber attack

An onshore cyber attack was also responsible for shutting down ANZ bank's online broking service, Etrade, Australia's second-largest, before Christmas.

Australian Federal Police national cyber-crime co-ordinator Superintendent Brad Marden said the agen-cy had been liaising with cy had been haising with several companies recently targeted in similar attacks. "No one is immune to attempts to access infor-mation contained on their

networks and adequate protection should be seen a cost of doing business in the digital age," he said.
